## Message from Daesa....

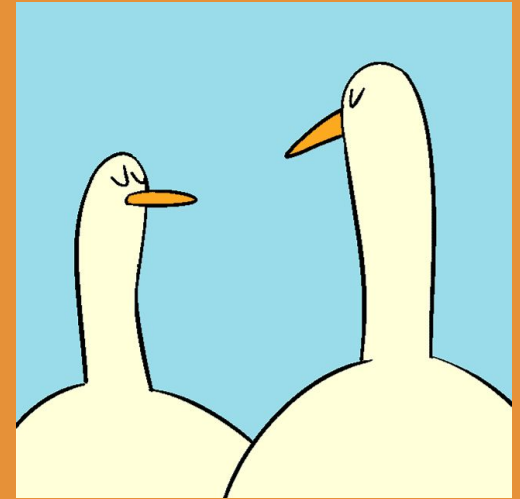
