Key Questions:

- 1. Why did the Vietnam War start?
- 2. Who is involved in the Vietnam War?
- 3. When was the Vietnam War?
- 4. Where did the Vietnam War take place?
- 5. Why did students protest in USA?
- 6. Why was the war such a loss for the USA?

Application of Knowledge:

Students should understand the final stages of the Vietnam War and the gradual exit of American troops. They additionally should be able to identify the results of the war and key reasons of the outcome, the political fall-out, the attitudes of the American people, and how it affected the overall track of the Cold War.
