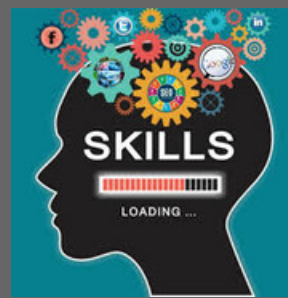


Today's technology has taken out a lot of the creativity for the students because of the platforms being used, we NEED to throw the creativity back into the schools

• ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO BE MAKERS

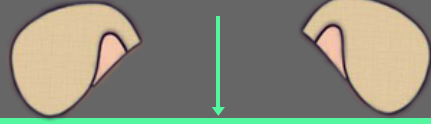
1. Students believe that digital skills are important for future careers
