LIMITATIONS

Certainly there are some limitations to using laptops in the classroom. The big concern is students will be distracted during class time. There is also the limitations of students having access to the Internet or to a laptop. The solution is to provide students without a laptop with one and allow time in class to complete tasks.

If the problem arises that students are getting distracted by those using laptops, allow for the two front rows to be for those handwriting notes.
