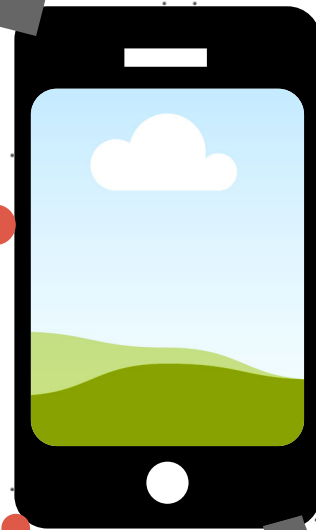
How some Ontario teachers are attempting to limit students' cellphone use

While using the specialized cases, Mr. Acheson's class @ St. Mary's school in Kitchen had a class average that was 8% higher

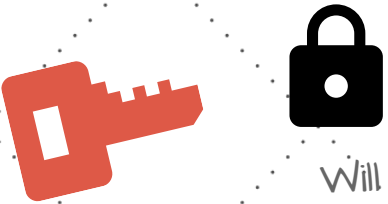


Ontario Premier Doug Ford, have suggested an outright ban of cellphones in schools to "maximize learning time."
